What do Sunflower County Fair Summer Camp Junior Counselors do?

A Junior Counselor is a liaison between campers and camp leaders. His/her job is to have fun with the campers while being a role model and encouraging a positive attitude at camp.

Junior Counselors help with daily activities, such as setting up snacks, washing dishes, assisting young children with crafts and activities, and clean up. Junior Counselors may be asked to help in both our Kindercamp program as well as Grades Camp.

Junior Counselors will never be left alone with campers, nor will they be directly responsible for their wellbeing.

Benefits

This position is not paid; however, up to a 50% tuition rebate will be granted upon successful completion of the week's duties. Please note, that rebates are not always awarded, and are subject to clearly defined parameters and must be approved by the coordinator. Parents may choose to give all or part of the rebate to their child.

This is a wonderful opportunity for junior high and high school students to take a leadership role and become more comfortable working with youth, creativity, and working as part of a team.

How to apply

Junior Counselors must submit a current photo, a personal statement (please write 200 words about why you would like to be a Junior Counselor) and a letter of recommendation from a teacher. Once the materials are received, they may be contacted by the Summer Camp Coordinator to arrange an in-person interview.

If chosen, Junior Counselors must arrive at camp by 8:00 am the day they begin. At this time, the Junior Counselors meet the Summer Camp Assistants and the Kindercamp Coordinator, and get acquainted with the facilities and prepare for the week.
